Confirmation of Compliance

Belarus

On the basis of paragraph 1.1 of paragraph 1 of the Decree of the President of the Republic Belarus of July 20, 2016 № 278 "On measures for mandatory confirmation matching "the Council of Ministers DECIDED:

1. To approve the list of objects of compulsory

National conformity verification system

conformity of the Republic of Belarus (hereinafter - the list).

2. To establish that the mandatory confirmation of conformity

be put into effect in respect of:

products referred to in sub-paragraphs 3.1, 3.2, 3.8 - 3.10, paragraph 3,
paragraphs 4 - 10, the list of services mentioned in paragraph 12 of the list -
from February 1, 2017 .;

products referred to in sub-paragraphs 3.3 and 3.7 of paragraph 3 of the list -
from April 1, 2017 .;

products referred to in paragraphs 3.4 - 3.6, paragraph 3 of the list -
from 1 September 2017 .;

professional competence of the personnel referred to in paragraph 13
list - from January 1, 2018

3. This resolution shall not apply to:

products that were in use (consumption), with the exception of
sporting and hunting weapons;

products imported by legal entities and individual
entrepreneurs as components, materials and

raw materials for use in their own production if they have

National certificate of conformity verification system

conformity of the Republic of Belarus for the finished products manufactured
using said components, and raw materials;

products imported as samples, exhibits and advertising

materials for exhibitions, trade fairs, advertising campaigns;

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products imported as samples and specimens for
tests for certification and the declaration of
conformity testing and research for other purposes;
products imported in individual copies (quantity)
provided one foreign trade contract, exclusively for
own use of legal entities and individual
businesses (including for research, study and test)
vvezshimi specified products, except sports and
hunting weapons;

non-food products, imported as a raw material,
materials and components for the execution of orders of foreign organizations
for the manufacture of products in accordance with the signed agreements,
not intended for sale on the territory of the Republic of Belarus;
products imported for use in scientific research
purposes, including for the implementation of research programs;
products sold in commission trade, adopted by the citizens;
goods (property), received as foreign
grant aid and international technical assistance;
property seized, arrested and confiscated by the verdict
(resolution) of the court or appeal to the state revenue other
way property on which execution is levied on account of
outstanding tax liabilities, unpaid fines, and
property, freed from arrest authority conducting the criminal proceedings;
goods intended for the prevention and elimination
natural disasters and other emergencies;
products intended to be sold in stores
free trade;
products imported for diplomatic or
consular missions of foreign states, representations
international organizations or intended exclusively for
ensuring operation of representative offices of foreign organizations,
located on the territory of the Republic of Belarus;
hunting and sporting weapons and ammunition imported
foreign citizens, stateless persons, temporarily
staying or temporarily residing in the Republic of Belarus on
the territory of the Republic of Belarus when invited
tour operator, travel agent or a legal entity, the leading hunting
Agriculture, the contract with the said tour operator, travel agent or
legal person to hunt or an invitation to participate in the
sporting events and permission of the Ministry of
Interior;

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products available in retail trading network to
maturity, at which required confirmation is entered
Conformity of this product;

products exported under foreign trade contracts.

4. To propose to the State Committee of forensic examinations
together with the State Committee for Standardization to develop
State of the Republic of Belarus standard setting
forensic requirements for hunting and sporting guns,
until February 1, 2017

5. Determine that the introduction of the technical
regulatory acts instead of the listed compulsory
conformity assessment carried out on the line entered in
effect of technical normative legal acts to make
the corresponding changes in the list.

6. This Decision shall enter into force on 23 October 2016
